What is P-TECH Construction?

P-TECH is a partnership between [Western Colorado Community College](#), [FCI Contractors, Inc.](#) and the [D51 Career Center](#). The goal is to provide students with an opportunity to earn an associate degree at the same time as earning their high school diploma, and work experience. Students can enter P-TECH as a 9th, 10th, or 11th grader and the program is designed to be completed in 4 to 6 years. P-TECH students take traditional high school courses, D51 Career Center Construction Technology course(s), P-TECH specific courses, and have opportunities to participate in apprenticeship programs and job shadows.

The D51 Career Center's partnership role is to support the Construction P-TECH program by offering district wide enrollment within the Colorado Career and Technical Education (CTE) [secondary pathway of Construction Technology](#) at the D51 Career Center campus, a recognized [Designated Career and Technical School \(DCTS\)](#) by the Colorado Department of Education.
